

SONG LIST TIPS

Here are a few tips concerning the selection of music for your event.

If you wish, I can provide a general song list or song styles list and you may highlight some of your favorites. This **is not required**, however some clients prefer to do this as a means of informing me of your general tastes in music and as an idea of your specific requirements. If you wish to pass on this option, rest assured that I will be reading your crowd as the performance goes along and making the best choices for each particular moment of your reception. I feel it is of the greatest importance to select the “right song at the right time”.

I have several years experience as a DJ and a bandleader and can instantly recognize what each event’s needs are. I’m sensitive to the “vibe” of every audience for whom I perform. I never proceed to the stage with a preconceived set of songs to play. I believe it is important to remain watchful of each moment and I am flexible to change on a dime if needed. I feel this gives your reception a pacing and variety that is never exactly duplicated from one function to the next.

You will also notice below that there is a space provided for your specific song requests. I call these the “must haves”. Here you may pick any number of songs that you definitely want to have played, provided there is enough time in the music portion of the reception. If there is a song you are interested in that I don’t have, I will do whatever I can to add it to my collection by the date of your reception. We can work together over phone and email to form the perfect song list for your event. I do have a wide variety of music available from many different styles and I’m confident I can accommodate all of your musical tastes. This has long been one of my trademarks.
